



MAKING YOUR ANNUAL MEMBER CONTRIBUTION 2023: JANUARY – DECEMBER

AWA is a responsive and relevant network that aims to reflect the real-world contexts experienced across the sector, from the cost of living crisis to practitioner wellbeing and development. Our regular activities, such as the Forum and Gathering, are informed by your ideas, thoughts and experiences. We are the only participatory arts network operating across the UK nations. ArtWorks Alliance is solely reliant on member income to cover core network costs, as described in the [Introduction to ArtWorks Alliance](#). We operate a 'pay as you can' sliding scale from which you choose your contribution.

*Please note, membership **renewals** are due in advance, and if not paid by 31st March it will take longer to process you as a member.*

- **Organisations:** £75 to £300
- **Individuals:** £10 to £25

We encourage those with larger budgets to contribute at or near the top of the scale, in solidarity with small organisations and individuals with more limited budgets. When you have decided on your contribution, please follow the instructions below. In order to limit administrative time managing membership, we have reduced the number of ways to make your payment to Bank Transfer only:

This will help us to track your payment and membership status. We will send a receipt following payment from info@artworksalliance.org.uk.
